March 31st is the last day to register your dog in Liberty Grove without paying a late fee. If you haven't done so please bring in or mail a copy of the rabies certificate showing the date the shot was given, the manufacturer of the serum, the serial number of the serum and all the information about the dog and owner. Spayed or neutered animals are \$3, regular are \$8. A late fee of \$5 will be added as of April 1st.

Weight limits on roads.

As of Feb. 26, 2016 weight limits have been placed on certain roads in the town. Because we didn't have a good deep freeze this year the frost in the ground as of this date is just about gone. Pavement begins to lift and buckle as the moisture from winter that is under it leaves. Heavy vehicles traveling over these roads can cause a lot of damage. If you are beginning a project that will require heavy vehicles please check the town web site for the list of roads that are restricted. CHAIRMAN'S NOTES

The Board decided not to proceed with a "wave study" at the Ellison Bay Marina. Major maintenance repairs need to be made at the marina in addition to storm water pipe replacement under Cedar Shore Road. Consideration was given to study the wave action with the possibility of building a break wall to protect the marina. The cost of the study in addition to the possibility of not receiving DNR or Fish & Wildlife approval for the construction of the wall were major considerations. The study was not included in the current budget. Baudhuin Engineering will proceed with developing plans for the maintenance project based on not having a break wall.

The April 19th Annual Town Meeting will have presentations from Door Tran and the Door County Humane Society on the services they provide to county residents. The Board will be seeking elector input on the Ellison Bay Community Center" Women's Club". Supervisor Gary Farber will provide information on the major problems facing the current building including projected costs. The Board has been considering the option of replacing the existing structure due to the condition of the current building and related maintenance costs.

TOWN ADOPTS TOWER SIGHTING ORDINANCE

At the Board meeting on March 2nd the Town Board adopted Ord. 2-16, Town Tower Sighting Ordinance. Because of the restrictions of the County tower ordinance the Board felt it was in the best interest of the Town to adopt its own. Ord. 2-16 allows the rules of the State Statute to control tower sightings which is less restrictive than the County ordinance.
