From the Town Chairman

All individuals in the state of Wisconsin are ordered to stay at home or at their place of residence, with limited exceptions. Individuals who are using shared or outdoor space other than their home or residence, must, at all times and to the extent possible, maintain social distancing of at least 6 feet from another person. Individuals do not need to maintain social distancing between family members in a single living unit or with other household members.

All individuals may leave their home or residence for a number of essential activities and functions including health and safety, such as picking up medications, visits with health care providers; obtaining groceries and food, buying gas or pet food, and other activities necessary to maintain the home or residence; outdoor activities, such as walking, biking, hiking or running while maintaining social distancing (does not include contact sports such as basketball); taking care of others, including friends and pets; and the travel associated with such tasks. (Emergency Order #12 County of Door.)

We all have the responsibility to ourselves, neighbors and community to obey the emergency orders issued by Door County and Liberty Grove. We are dealing with a situation that, if not contained and stopped, will dramatically alter Door County. Anyone who thinks this does not apply to them needs to wake up now and understand how dangerous this virus is. To those that are following the guidelines thank you being a responsible member, visitor, or second homeowner to our community.

The Board and committees are now using Zoom to conduct meetings to avoid close contact. It is a video/audio teleconference service which is also open to the public to attend. Links to the meetings are provided on posted agendas. Attendance can be done via the internet and/or phone. Instructions are available on the Town Web site or by calling the office. The Town Office is closed to walk in traffic but available by telephone and email to answer questions.

Letters are being sent to people wishing to reserve a slip at the Ellison Bay Marina informing them that it may be closed this summer due to the high water with potential damage from strong winds off the bay. All Town parks and facilities will remain closed until our emergency resolution is rescinded with the exception of the Town office. Steps are being taking to mitigate the possible undermining of a section of North Bay Road due to the high water. The most recent report from the Corps of Engineers indicates that high water levels broke the record for March. The high water is not expected to abate this spring and summer. Paving and chip sealing of designated roads and road maintenance will continue as planned for this year baring any event that disrupts the schedule.

The pandemic emergency has highlighted the need for adequate internet service within the Town. As has been noted before currently the only provider of service within the Town needs to install wireless towers to extend reaching those without service or limited service.



SeniorCare is a prescription drug assistance program for Wisconsin residents who are 65 years of age or older and meet the enrollment requirements. The program is designed to help seniors with their prescription drug costs.

To enroll in SeniorCare you must:

- Be a Wisconsin resident.
- Be a U.S. citizen or have qualifying immigrant status.
- Be 65 years of age or older.

Fill out a SeniorCare application.

Every senior enrolling in SeniorCare must pay an annual \$30 fee. The earliest you can apply is during the calendar month of your 65th birthday. If you are already age 65 or older, you can apply at any time. Your benefits will begin in the month after you apply.

Your annual income determines your level of coverage in SeniorCare and how much SeniorCare will cover. See the <u>Annual Income Limit</u> table for out-of-pocket expenses and benefits for each level of participation.
