

## **Town of Liberty Grove**

### **Resolution # 1-17, Post Office rules on same zip code deliveries**

WHEREAS, the Town of Liberty Grove is at the northern tip of the Door County, Wisconsin peninsula; and,

WHEREAS, historically locally deposited mail to be delivered in Ellison Bay, Sister Bay and Washington Island has been cancelled in their respective post offices and delivered the following day; and,

WHEREAS, mail is picked up and routed to Green Bay by 4:30 pm; and,

WHEREAS, time sensitive locally addressed mail that is deposited after 4:30 pm will experience unnecessary delays in local delivery due to being picked up and hauled to Green Bay the next day, resulting in a 2 day or longer lag time in delivery; and,

WHEREAS, the population of Liberty Grove would not create a large volume of mail to be cancelled and sorted locally;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Liberty Grove Town Board to urge the Governor and Federal and State representatives to request that the United States Postal Service resume cancelling and delivering mail to a local zip code address when requested, provided the volume of mail is reasonable, rather than trucking it to another city to be sorted and returned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town Board directs the Clerk to send a copy of this resolution to the Wisconsin Towns Association, our State Legislators, our representatives in the Federal Government, to Governor Scott Walker and to the League of Wisconsin Municipalities.
