NATIONAL TOURISM WEEK DECLARATION

WHEREAS, travel and tourism is one of America's largest industries with \$770 billion in direct travel expenditure by domestic and international travelers, and

WHEREAS, travel and tourism is one of America's largest employers with 7.7 million direct travel related jobs, and

Whereas, tourism in Door County generated an estimated \$483.9 million in visitor spending in 2008, and

Whereas, employees earned an estimated \$179.2 million in wages and proprietary income generated from tourism in Door County ('08), and

Whereas, tourism spending supported 8,471 full time equivalent jobs in Door County ('08), and

Whereas, local government revenues collected as a result of tourism spending amounted to an estimated \$21.9 million ('08), and

Whereas, Door County is a four season travel destination and has been a popular vacation retreat for over a century, and

Whereas, tourism is recognized in the United States during National Tourism Week, May 8—16, 2010, therefore

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Town of Liberty Grove in Door County, Wisconsin celebrates National Tourism Week, May 8—16, 2010 and declares Thursday, May 13 as Tourism Day in the Town of Liberty Grove.
