

RESOLUTION 4-02

RESOLUTION OPPOSING GOVERNOR MCCALLUM'S PROPOSAL
TO ELIMINATE THE SHARED REVENUE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Governor McCallum has proposed an immediate cut of \$350 million in the Shared Revenue, Expenditure Restraint and Small Municipalities Shared Revenue Program for cities, villages, towns and counties in Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS, Governor McCallum has proposed the complete elimination of all shared Revenue Related Programs in 2004; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Liberty Grove is budgeted to receive \$45,123 from Shared Revenue in the current budget year, which represents 4.5% of our total annual budget; and

WHEREAS, the elimination of Shared Revenue Related Programs would have a devastating impact on our community and would force significant cuts in essential public services;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Liberty Grove strongly opposes Governor McCallum's proposal for slashing and eliminating the Shared Revenue Program, and requests that the Governor work with Wisconsin towns to arrive at a mutually agreeable solution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution be sent to the Governor and the state legislative delegation representing this community and to the Wisconsin Towns Association.
