TOWN OF LIBERTY GROVE RESOLUTION 1-08

Whereas, Wisconsin Statute 7.32 allows for the town board to establish the number of poll workers assigned to each election; and

Whereas, the minimum number of poll workers needed may vary from election to election: therefore

Be it hereby resolved, that pursuant to s. 7.32, Wis. Stat., the minimum number of election officials required to work at the polling place in the Town of Liberty Grove during an election is three (3). However, the Town Clerk/administrator may assign additional poll workers if he/she believes they are needed for a given election. The number of poll workers assigned shall always be an odd number.

Be it further resolved, this resolution shall remain in effect until rescinded at a meeting of the Town Board.
