#### FROM YOUR TOWN CHAIRMAN

The Board has approved the STR Compliance contract with LTAS Technologies Inc.(Hamari) for monitoring STR's within Liberty Grove. Hamari is based in Toronto Canada and will be replacing our former monitoring service. The cost is \$4500.00 a year. Most STR locations are in residential zoning areas. Our ordinance has adopted several provisions for licensing a STR. The most important is compliance with the private on-site wastewater treatment system authorized by the County Sanitarians Office.

The Board has approved the contract with Farr Technologies for the Broadband Engineering Design Proposal. This is another step in providing our entire Community with fiber optic access. Farr Technologies was one of four bidders to do the Design Proposal. The work involves a parcel-to-parcel observation and determination where the fiber optic cable can be buried or suspended on power poles. This includes all public roads and private roads. Once the design is completed it will be possible to issue an RFP for the construction of fiber to the home project for Liberty Grove. The administration, at the request of the Board, is working with our attorneys and Nsight on partnership agreements for the Northport Project and the fiber to home project. Construction on the Northport Project is scheduled to be completed this year. Early indications from Nsight, barring unforeseen circumstances, is that the fiber to home project could be underway in 2023. We will be holding informational sessions to keep the Community apprised of the project and answer community questions. Updates will be posted on the Town website once the project commences.

On recommendation from the Technology Committee the electric charging station at the Death's Door Maritime Museum will be upgraded to provide information on the location of the station that may be accessed by electric vehicle owners when traveling in Door County. The charging station at the Women's Club in Ellison Bay will not be installed due to circumstances that interfered with the installation. That unit is not compatible with upgrading like the one at the museum. Currently there are no plans to replace that unit.

#### R reminder to all new residents of Liberty Grove

Currently, the Town does not provide garbage pickup at your residence. That must be arranged through private garbage hauling companies that might service your road. The Town does provide a recycling drop off site at Going Garbage on Old Stage Rd. There you can bring in your Liberty Grove recycling divided into two separations. One is flattened cardboard, newspapers, magazines, and junk mail. Cardboard items should not be wet and free of food or bathroom debris. The other is aluminum cans, tin cans, plastics numbered 1-7 and unbroken glass bottles and jars. All lids from bottles and jars should be removed and thrown in regular trash. All food containers should be rinsed out well. Items not allowed are Styrofoam and plastic bags. Foil trays can be recycled if they have been completely cleaned out.

#### Lake Michigan Lake Levels

Over last month, Lake Superior rose 1 inch, Lake Michigan-Huron remained at a similar level, and Lakes St. Clair, Erie and Ontario fell 1, 2, and 6 inches, respectively. Lakes Superior, Michigan-Huron, St. Clair, and Erie levels are above their and Lake Ontario 4 inches below long-term monthly average levels. Lakes Michigan-Huron, St. Clair, and Erie are below levels from 22 July 2021; while, Lakes Superior and Ontario are 2 and 1 inches above respective 2021 levels. Forecasts for August 29<sup>th</sup> show lake levels falling, but Lake Superior is to remain at current level. See our <u>Daily Levels</u> web page for more water level information.

Defibs4DoorCounty.org

- Raise funds to increase the number of automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) in key locations throughout the county and help save lives
- Match an anonymous \$75,000 donation to add approximately 80 new AEDs to Door County's inventory
- Address an important public safety need:
  - For every minute that passes without CPR and defibrillation, the chances of survival decrease 7-10%\*
  - Most cardiac arrests occur in public places are "shockable," making AEDs in public places vital\*
  - Over 2 million people visit Door County each year\*\*
  - 39% of Door County's year-round population is 60 or older\*\*\*

#### When is the Defibs4DoorCounty Campaign?

- Fundraising now through Labor Day 2022
- Application process for AEDS is in two phases: February 1 for government agencies and April 1 for other organizations (see below)

#### Who Can Request An AED?

- Government agencies (police, fire, EMS and DNR, may submit applications for new AEDs starting February 1
- Schools, places of worship, theaters, & venues/businesses with large public gatherings) can apply starting
   April 1



## HELP US STOP VANDALISM IN DOOR COUNTY PARKS

Since the beginning of July there have been multiple acts of vandalism involving fecal material in various County Park Restrooms. Offenders of vandalism will be prosecuted for Class A Misdemeanor offense, punishable by up to 9 months imprisonment and/or fine of up to \$10,000 for each offense/occurrence.
