#### FROM YOUR TOWN CHAIRMAN

The Budget Hearing is scheduled for Tuesday November 15 beginning at 7:00 PM at the Town Hall. I would like to thank the Finance Committee and administration for their time and effort in developing the budget. It is always a challenging balancing act. Finance committee members are the Town Board members Nancy Goss (chairperson), Cathy Ward, Janet Johnson, Dan Watts, and myself, plus community members Karen Studebaker, Gary Kemp and Andrew Gantman. The Committee met beginning on August 29<sup>th</sup>, and continued on alternate Mondays, until their final meeting on October 28th. Clerk/Treasurer Stacy Bell and Administrator Bud Kalms prepare the budget and answer questions from Committee members and then make adjustments as requested. The result is posted on the Town website and will be available at the Budget Hearing.

The Board is waiting for a reply from FARR Technologies regarding the Broadband Engineering Design Contract for Town-wide fiber optic cable. At the suggestion of Nsight, FARR was selected to do the engineering design. Our legal firm, BoardmanClark, worked with Nsight attorneys to prepare a contract that has been submitted to FARR. The design will be submitted for contract bids to install the fiber optical cable Town-wide.

Door County has hired a Broadband Coordinator and established a Broadband Committee to help guide the deployment of Fiber to the Premise (FTTP) throughout Door County. In addition your local municipality has a committee that is working at a local level.

We need all residents, property and business owners to participate in this survey to show what internet services are in place in the County. It is projected to cost \$140 million for Fiber to the Premise in Door County. It is critical for us to obtain as much Federal and State funding as possible and not leave anyone behind.

#### KLENKE COTTAGE

With the season concluded, projects like the ones shown here can begin. The Klenke Cottage came from Garrett Bay Road to our site in the fall of 2020. The building was set on a foundation this past summer. Renovations for this structure include siding repair, new roofing, and replacing broken windows. A new entrance ramp will be added at a later date. Once the building is finished, display areas will be created inside.
